SFA Scholarship Application Process

We will be accepting packets for 2022 Awards through 1 June 2022.

“Eligible applicants must complete the online application form and submit all required documents at <https://www.specialforcesassociation.org>

The following items are required for consideration:

- a) A completed online application.
- b) All documents submitted by the applicant will at a minimum have the applicant’s name and email address on them for identification.
- c) Documents
 - 1) A sponsor letter from the SFA member that states full name, member number, and relationship to applicant.
 - 2) A personal letter from the applicant stating his/her education, career plans, aspirations, and the planned use of the funds.
 - 3) Applicant’s most recent transcript, SAT/ACT score, and/or other evidence of scholastic achievement.
 - 4) Reference letter(s) from teacher, counselor, or school official (minimum of one is required)
 - 5) A summary of extra-curricular activities, non-academic achievements, and hobbies.
 - 6) A copy of an acceptance letter from the institute of higher learning or letter from the registrar that the student has already been enrolled. Please include student number.
- d) Essay Question: 2 Essay questions. No more than 300 words each:
 - 1) In your view what is the most pressing issue in America today and why?
 - 2) Given your answer to question (a), what would you do to fix it?
- e) Awardee’s will be required to provide the address of the registrar’s office at the institute of higher learning where the funds will be sent in the names of the awardee. Funds will not be directly disbursed to the awardee.
- f) Applicants are evaluated on overall content, scholastic achievement, references, and non-academic activities and achievements. It is critical that applications include all information requested regardless of the year of education that they are currently enrolled. Consideration is given regardless of the grade level of the applicant (i.e. high school senior, under-graduate or graduate student).
